Villa has total surface of approx. 300 m2 and a land plot of 500 m2 which is big enough for swimming pool of m2 with whirlpool option, summer kitchen, barbecue zone, landscaped garden.

First level: salon with kitchen, bathroom, bedroom, laundry and terrace.

Second level: spacious salon with chimney, dining area with kitchen, bathroom, bedroom, sauna and terrace with barbecue.

It is possible to accomodate 12 people on the villa.

Parking lot for 2 cars is 20 meters away from the villa.

It is one of the most peaceful, calm and green areas of Ciovo which has become a peninsula due a bridge in Trogir. There is a new second bridge being constructed to finally turn Ciovo into a true mainland.

Dalmatia is a long belt of Adriatic coast extending from Zadar islands to the outskirts of Cavtat. It is the major part of Croatian seaside and without any doubt – the heart of it.

There are several towns in Dalmatia which are now the main areas of attraction for tourists due to their ancient history and unique extent of preservation. Narrow streets of Zadar, Sibenik, Trogir, Split and Dubrovnik are the same as they were in Medieval times. Stone-paved streets, attached Palazzo-style buildings, impressive Cathedrals and ruins dating back to the Greeks and the Romans create an unforgettable image of Dalmatia. Steady expansion of three airports of Zadar, Split (Kastela) and Dubrovnik (Cilipi) make Dalmatia more and more accessible. Modern highways connect Dalmatia to Zagreb and Europe. Infrastructure is rapidly developing with new 5-star resorts, large shopping molls opening every year, PLODINE,

LIDL, KONZUM supermarket chains coming to every village.

But the main role still belongs to crystal clear sea with myriads of picturesque bays, handful of small islands and blue silhouettes of the coastal mountains. Intoxicating pine aroma makes you forget the noise of big cities. In couple of days spend in Dalmatia all the troubles and problems float away.
