Tucked away on the edge of a small, quiet settlement with few neighbors, this villa offers complete tranquility.

Spanning 270 m² of living space, the villa sits on a beautifully landscaped and fully fenced garden covering 2,100 m², ensuring total privacy.

Upon entering, you are welcomed by the authentic warmth of Istrian interior design, featuring prominent stone accents on the walls and original solid wood furniture—each piece telling its own unique story. The attention to detail and high-quality renovation work are evident throughout the property, leaving a lasting impression.

The interior layout is designed for comfort and openness.

The ground floor features a large open-plan area with a high ceiling, flooding the space with natural light. Here, you will find a spacious living room perfect for socializing, complete with a functional wood-burning fireplace. A large dining area occupies the center of the space, leading to a modern kitchen that blends seamlessly with the rustic charm of the home. Additionally, on this level, there is a guest bathroom, a utility room, and a storage area, which the current owners plan to convert into a spa by the next season.

Upstairs, all the bedrooms are thoughtfully located. The master bedroom enjoys its own private section of the villa with an en-suite bathroom, accessed directly from the ground floor. The other two bedrooms, each with their own bathroom, are accessed via a staircase from the living room. The villa is being sold fully furnished, including recently restored solid wood antique pieces that add great value and charm.

Outside, the expansive garden hosts an 8.70-meter round pool, perfect for spending quality time with family and friends. A brick barbecue area with a wooden gazebo provides the ideal setting for outdoor dining and gatherings.

Originally a traditional Istrian stone ruin, the villa underwent a complete renovation in 2013, incorporating modern solutions while maintaining its authentic character. Further investments were made this year to



enhance the overall quality and comfort of the villa.

This remarkable property is a rare find—offering a perfect blend of tradition, luxury, and modern living in the heart of Istria.
