Amidst the greenery that surrounds this fascinating town, 8 km from the beaches, there stands a house, now for sale, equipped with a swimming pool.

Here too are four bedrooms, two bathrooms, and a hallway, offering ample accommodation.

The garden, enclosed and brimming with greenery and Mediterranean flora, adds further enchantment. The crowning glory is the swimming pool with its sun-drenched deck, creating a peaceful haven for rest and relaxation.

With its excellent location and thoughtful design, both inside and out, this property presents an ideal opportunity for a comfortable family home or a sound investment in the burgeoning world of tourist rentals.
