The area of the villa is 307 m2, the area of the plot is 450 m2.

The villa is divided into 4 separate apartments. Therefore, it can be used both as a private object and as a tourist.

The terrace in front of the building can be used as a pier for two yachts.

The first apartment (duplex on two levels): four bedrooms, three bathrooms, lounge, terrace 225 m2, direct access to the sea.

The second apartment: bedroom, bathroom, lounge, terrace.

The third apartment: two bedrooms, bathroom, lounge, terrace.

Fourth apartment: a magnificent two bedroom pente-house with bathroom and terrace with a breathtaking view of the sea.

#### Distinctive features:

- white stone from the island of Brac, from the same quarry, as the stone of the facade of the White House in Washington
- the villa was used to live the film crew of the film MAMMA MIA
- planned to build a pool of 8x4 meters
- planned construction of a crane for yachts
