Two old stone houses for complete modernization, in a small Dalmatian town Selca on the island of Brac. The houses are 2 km from the sea (5 minutes by car) and beautiful bays and offer a open view of the sea and the mainland.

They are surrounded by garden of 700 sq.m.

House 1

Old family stone house, built before 1968. 100% legal. The total area of the house is 160m2 (2 floors per x 80m2). It consists of ground floor, first floor and roof.

House 2

Family house, built of concrete-brick, tile.
The total area is 80m2. It consists of ground floor and roof.
Legalized in 2012

The houses are partly surrounded by a stone wall 2m high

INFRASTRUCTURE:

- Water network with 2 separate meters.
- Electrical network with 2 separate meters.
- Drainage: local sewerage.
- Asphalt road.
- Street lights.

All facilities to meet basic needs are located at 200 meters.

Great investment.

We recommend to restore the houses and make villas for renting out of them.

Two villas with common swimming pool could be ideal new format.

Overall additional expenses borne by the Buyer of real estate in Croatia are around 7% of property cost in total, which includes: property transfer tax (3% of property value), agency/brokerage commission (3%+VAT on commission), advocate fee (cca 1%), notary fee, court registration fee and official certified translation expenses.
